## NOTICE

It recently came to our attention that the soft carrycase, used to store and transport certain Tektronix probes, that was sold to you as an accessory to such probes included a transparent plastic cardholder window stitched at the exterior of the soft carrycase containing cadmium that may not fully meet the substance restrictions set by the EU RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU / REACH. The cadmium is only present in the transparent cardholder window, usually used for the probes model card. The total mass of cadmium potentially in each cardholder on the carrycase is limited to about 0.2 mg, which is above the regulatory limit of 0.1 mg for this cardholder.

The carrycase is used with the probes listed in **Annex 1** of this notice.

This issue will not affect the usage/performance of the carrycase itself or of any of the probes to their published specifications. Further, this issue should have no impact on human health, as cadmium is generally absorbed by ingestion or inhalation; dermal exposure is not regarded to be significant. However, the carrycase cannot be imported into the EU and EEA countries as well as the UK.

The cardholder can be left on the carrycase for the lifetime of the carrycase and, at the end of the carrycase's lifetime, it may be disposed of with the carrycase.
